# Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound Captain Harbor Sunday Series One Design Racing - Notice of Race

#### **RULES**

- This Series will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the
  prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the Ideal 18 and Laser (ILCA) class rules, and the class rules of any other
  one-design class that chooses to compete.
- Lasers may substitute non-class legal sails, hull, or parts that are built according to the ILCA handbook and builders manual. The equipment must be mass produced and readily available.

#### **ENTRIES**

- This series is open to all boats of the Ideal 18 and Laser (ILCA) classes. Other one-design classes with a minimum of three starters will be permitted to race, if they have notified the Organizing Authority at <a href="mailto:yrasundays@gmail.com">yrasundays@gmail.com</a> a week in advance. Each class shall be responsible for setting any eligibility and/or entry requirements. All skippers shall register online in advance through the Series' website at <a href="https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26111">https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/26111</a>.
- The registration is open for Ideal 18 and Laser skippers. Racers must be registered ahead of their first race to qualify for awards.
- The registration fee is \$30 for an Ideal 18 skipper and \$60 for a Laser skipper, if you are a registered member of the YRA. YRA membership is available for \$25 here.

### **SCHEDULE**

- Racing will be held Sundays June 11th to August 27th except June 18, July 2, and August 6. June 25 will be hosted by OGYC as part of the Solstice Regatta a qualifier for the Sally Finkbeiner Trophy.
- Participating classes may choose to not race on specified days. Any non-sailing days will be communicated by fleet representatives to their members and that day's race committee.
- The starting sequence of the first warning shall be 1400 for one-design vessels. Races will start as soon as possible after the last vessel finishes.
- No warning signal shall be made after 1700
- As many races shall be run each race day as practicable

### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### **QUALIFICATION**

- Complete a race on 40% of the race days, rounded down to the nearest whole number. A qualifying
  race day is a scheduled race day in which at least one race is completed
- The Ideal 18 skipper of the first race shall check in with the Race Committee with his/her first and last name. A second skipper on the same boat shall, by the end of the race day, email yrasundays@gmail.com to provide the race numbers in which he/she skippered
- YRA competitors shall maintain a current membership at YRALIS. Visit <u>www.yralis.org</u> for instructions.
- Competitors must be registered YRA members ahead of racing on that day, if they want to be considered qualified.

### **PRIZES**

- YRA competitors in fleets with a sufficient number of YRA members will be awarded prizes by the YRALIS
- Additional prizes may be awarded by the individual fleets or participating Clubs. Contact your Fleet Captain for more details
